

## **URINE CYTOLOGY**

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Required Specimen Type	Urine sample
Medical Supplies	<ul> <li>Sterile container (to collect urine)</li> <li>Sterile container with 10ml of CytolytTM (for transport)</li> <li>Biohazard bag</li> <li>Urine Cytology Requisition: RR-10-RQ-125</li> </ul>
General Guidelines	<ol> <li>All specimens must include a double identification (first and last name of the patient and date of birth or RAMQ number).</li> <li>The use of gloves is required when handling all biological specimens.</li> <li>A valid requisition must include the following information:         <ul> <li>First and last name of the patient, date of birth or medicare number and gender.</li> <li>Date and time of specimen collection and signature of collector.</li> <li>Physician's full name, signature and license number (or other qualified prescriber).</li> <li>Any relevant clinical information.</li> <li>Requested tests.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
Patient Preparation	<ul> <li>First urine of the morning should not be collected.</li> <li>It is recommended to collect 1 sample per day for 3 consecutive days.</li> <li>For women: sample should not be collected during menstruation.</li> </ul>
Specimen Collection Instructions	<ol> <li>Do <u>not</u> collect the first urine of the morning.</li> <li>When the next urge to urinate arises, wash hands with soap and water and dry them thoroughly.</li> <li>Open sterile urine container <u>without liquid</u> and collect urine as follows:         <ul> <li>Begin urinating in the toilet and then stop.</li> <li>Urinate in the container (at least 30 mL is required).</li> <li>Eliminate the last part of your urine into the toilet if necessary.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Open the container <u>with the 10 mL Cytolyt<sup>™</sup> solution</u>:         <ul> <li>Pour 30 mL of urine into the container with the solution. The total volume in the container <u>should not exceed 40 mL</u>.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Close the container s follows:         <ul> <li>First and last name of patient.</li> <li>Date of birth or medicare number.</li> <li>Date and time of collection.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Place all 3 samples in the biohazard bag and insert the requisition in the side pocket of the bag.</li> <li>Return the 3 samples to the doctor or laboratory <u>as soon as possible</u>.</li> </ol>

Specimen Conservation and Stability	<ul> <li>8 days room temperature: in the Cytolyt solution.</li> <li>4 hours refrigerated<sup>1</sup>: without preservative.</li> </ul>
