Medical supplies General Guidelines	Container with preservative solution / three per kit
	Biohazard bag
	1) All specimens must include a double identification (first and last name of the patient and date of
	birth or Medicare number).
	2) The use of gloves is required when handling all biological specimens.3) A valid requisition must include the following information :
	 Physician's full name, signature and license number (or other qualified prescriber). Any relevant clinical information.
	Requested tests.
Patient preparation	It is recommended to collect 3 separate samples for this analysis;
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	 Laxatives or antibiotics should be avoided for a period of one week prior to the stool collection, unless otherwise specified by a physician. Rectal enemas should not be performed one week prior
	to collection.
Specimen Collection	1) Collect three (3) specimens allowing 2-3 <u>non-consecutive days</u> between each collection. For
Instruction	practical reasons, two (2) specimens collected within 2-3 days is now considered acceptable.
	2) Make sure to collect stool on a clean and dry surface or in a container such as a bedpan, a plastic
	bag, plastic wrap (e.g., Saran wrap) or a clean and dry newspaper. Choose the method that is mo
	convenient to you. It is important the stool does not contain any urine;
	3) Open the container;
	4) Collect a small quantity of stool from each side and from the middle by using the spatula provide
	in the container;
	5) The stool portions should be added progressively into the container,
	until the line indicated in yellow has been reached (Figure 8);
	The total amount must be equal to the line indicated on the
	container. Any sample in which the total quantity is over or under
	the line will not be processed;
	Pay attention to if mucus or blood is present in the stool, samples
	should be collected from those areas. Figure 8:
	6) Close container tightly; Ova & Parasite containers
	7) Identify the container:
	Last and first name of the patient
	Date of birth or RAMQ number
	Date and time of collection
	8) Place containers in a biohazard bag and insert the requisition in the pocket of the bag;
	9) Wash hands thoroughly;
