

## **PINWORM TEST**

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Required Specimen Type	Rectal sampling
Medical Supplies	<ul> <li>A frosted end glass slide for each sample collection;</li> <li>Transparent adhesive tape for each sample collection (not wider than the slide);</li> <li>A slide container for each slide;</li> <li>Gloves;</li> <li>Other sample collection kits may be used (please check with the laboratory);</li> <li>Biohazard bag.</li> </ul>
General Guidelines	<ol> <li>All specimens must include a double identification (first and last name of the patient and date of birth or Medicare number).</li> <li>The use of gloves is required when handling all biological specimens.</li> <li>A valid requisition must include the following information :         <ul> <li>First and last name of the patient, date of birth or Medicare number and gender.</li> <li>Date and time of specimen collection and signature of collector.</li> <li>Physician's full name, signature and license number (or other qualified prescriber).</li> <li>Any relevant clinical information.</li> <li>Requested tests.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
Patient Preparation	The sample should be taken first thing in the morning, before bathing and before any bowel movement.
Specimen Collection Instructions	<ol> <li>Before beginning the procedure, hands should be washed and dried thoroughly and protective gloves must be worn during collection.</li> <li>Separate buttocks and press the tacky surface of the tape against several areas of the anal region;</li> <li>Once the specimen is collected, apply the tacky surface of the tape on the slide;</li> <li>Using a lead pencil, identify on the frosted end of the slide the following information:         <ul> <li>First and last name;</li> <li>Date of birth and/or Medicare number;</li> <li>Collection date and time.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Place slide into a slide container and place in a biohazard bag, with the requisition in the side pocket of the bag.</li> <li>Remove gloves and wash hands;</li> <li>Return sample to the laboratory or physician's office as soon as possible.</li> </ol>
Additional Information	<ul> <li>Collection of 3 consecutive specimens is recommended;</li> <li>For symptomatic cases, 1 specimen may be sufficient</li> </ul>
Specimen Conservation and Stability	24 hours at room temperature
