Required Specimen Type	Sperm sample
Medical Supplies	<ul> <li>Sterile container, the use of any other container may render the sperm immobile and therefore will be unacceptable for testing;</li> <li>Opaque bag to provide the sample in a confidential manner (for CDL head office only);</li> <li>Sperm Analysis requisition <u>RR-50-RQ-001E</u>;</li> <li>Biohazard bag.</li> </ul>
General Guidelines	<ol> <li>All specimens must include a double identification (first and last name of the patient and date of birth or Medicare number).</li> <li>The use of gloves is required when handling all biological specimens.</li> <li>A valid requisition must include the following information :         <ul> <li>First and last name of the patient, date of birth or Medicare number and gender.</li> <li>Date and time of specimen collection and signature of collector.</li> <li>Physician's full name, signature and license number (or other qualified prescriber).</li> <li>Any relevant clinical information.</li> <li>Requested tests.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
Patient Preparation	<ol> <li>The patient should abstain from sexual activity for <u>2 to 7 days</u> prior to providing a sample, unless otherwise specified by a physician;</li> <li>Sexual activity should not be avoided for more than 1 to 2 weeks prior to the 2 to 7 days abstinence period, because long periods of sexual inactivity can result in less active sperm.</li> <li>Alcohol should be avoided 24 hours prior to test and the day of sample production.</li> <li>Semen activity may vary from day to day, for this reason it is recommended to analyse 2 or 3 different samples within a 3 month period (upon physician's request);</li> <li>Condoms are not acceptable for semen collection. Condoms contain spermicide used to immobilize sperm, making any motility evaluation impossible.</li> <li>Lubricants should be avoided (it can affect results).</li> <li>It is recommended to collect the specimen in the morning. If it's not possible, the physician should be consulted.</li> <li>It is recommended to provide the sample at CDL's head office (5990 Côte-des-Neiges). If this not possible, the specimen must be returned to CDL within 1 hour of collection and must remain at 20 <sup>Q</sup>C - 37 <sup>Q</sup>C during transportation.</li> <li><i>Please note that the samples are accepted from 8AM to 8PM from Monday to Friday and Sunday from 9AM to 3PM.</i></li> </ol>
Specimen Collection Instructions	<ol> <li>Open sterile container and proceed with the collection method of masturbation or coitus interruptus.</li> <li>The entire specimen must be collected directly into the container. If a portion of semen is lost, the sample should be discarded and another collection should be attempted at a later date;</li> <li>Close the container tightly and indicate the date and time on the container;</li> <li>Disinfect hands after specimen collection.</li> <li>Return within 45 minutes, if the sample is not collected at the laboratory.</li> <li>Note: The first and last name of the patient's partner must be written on the requisition.</li> </ol>
